IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that sale is approved and				
confirmed.				
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the private selling				
officer convey to the purchaser a deed to the property, accept delivery of the deed, and record the				
deed.				
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that a writ of possession is				
awarded to the purchaser.				
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the order of				
distribution in the decree of foreclosure previously entered herein is amended to read as follows:				
FIRST: To the Clerk of Courts the costs of this case including: the sum of \$ payable to plaintiff for the title reports filed herein; the cost of the appraisal required by RC 2329.17 in the sum of \$; the cost of the advertisement required by RC 2329.26 in the sum of; the portion of the fees and costs incurred by the private selling officer taxable as costs in the sum of \$ [1.5% of the sale price]; and the fees charged by escrow agent in the sum of				
SECOND: IF THE PLAINTIFF IS THE PURCHASER AND HAS ELECTED TO FORGO THE PAYMENT FROM THE SALE PROCEEDS OF CERTAIN TAXES AS PROVIDED IN R.C. §323.47(B):

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the escrow agent pay the funds in its possession according to the above amended order of distribution.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, pursuant to RC 2329.152(D)(1)(c), the sum distributed to the private selling officer under "THIRD" above may not be included in the calculation of any deficiency judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, pursuant to Civ. R. 54(B), there is no just reason for delay.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, pursuant to Civ.R. 58(B), the Clerk of Courts must serve, in a manner prescribed by Civ.R. 5(B), all parties not in

default for failure to appear notice of this judgment and its	date of entry upon the journal and must
note the service on the appearance docket.
